This is the second meeting of the Community Council for this year

The meeting was opened with a discussion to approve the minutes from the previous meeting.

- P. Miller motioned for the minutes to be approved

- All were in favor.

Principal L. Smith presented the report card information for Viewmont.

- Viewmont's grade is currently a "B"
- We did not have enough students in the English as a Second Language (ESL) category to calculate school scores. Viewmont has therefore exited from the Targeted Support and Intervention (TSI) designation.

Viewmont Elementary is generally meeting achievement standards in most areas. Lower scoring areas have improved since last year, and higher scoring areas have stayed steady. This year's averages, across all categories, are above state and district averages. All of this information is available through the data gateway.

The Council discussed the Acadience Reading and Math data. Generally, the majority of students are doing well at all grade levels. It was noted that a slippage in scores from the end of last year to the beginning of this year is normal since students tend to forget a little over summer break.

The Council reviewed Viewmont's Safe Technology and Digital Citizenship Report. There were a few changes made:

- The Seesaw application was removed for Kindergarten students
- The Flashlight 360 application is gone, and has been replaced with Summitt K12
- Net Ref was the old monitoring program used by teachers, but the Murray School District is working on a replacement called "NetWize"
